The Athanasian Creed is the most recent and longest of the three creeds to which we subscribe. Most historians would agree it was not written by St. Athanasius of the 4<sup>th</sup> century, but came about during the 5<sup>th</sup> or early 6<sup>th</sup> centuries and others attributed it to him.
